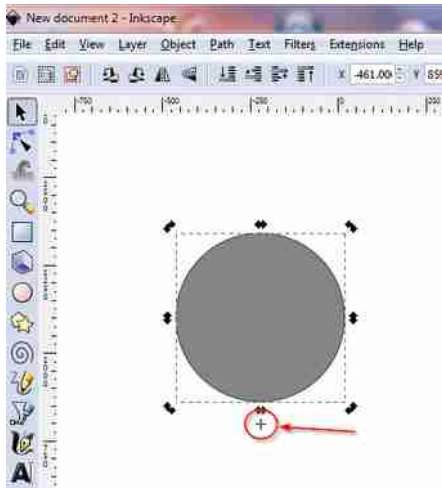


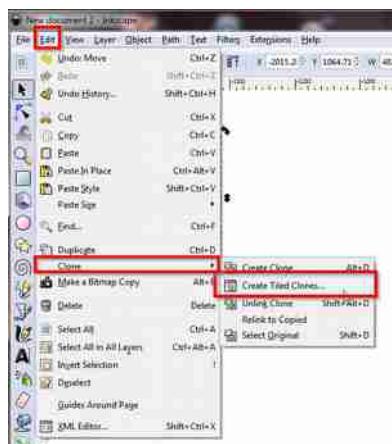
How to create a rosette in inkscape

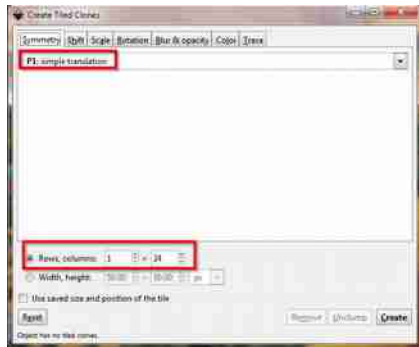
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Draw a circle and move the center.

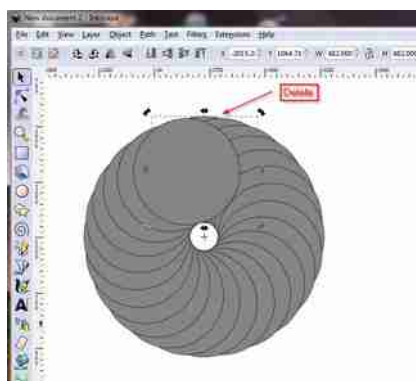
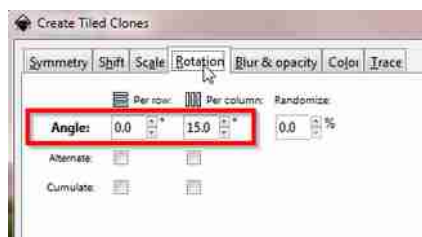
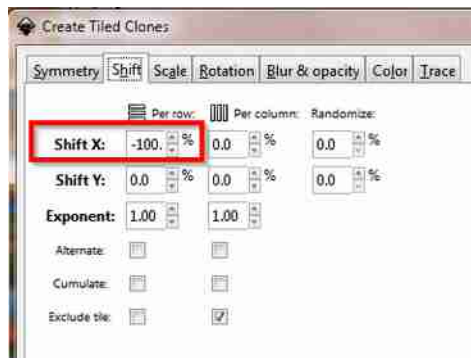


With the "Tiled Clone" tool now may the circle be duplicated.





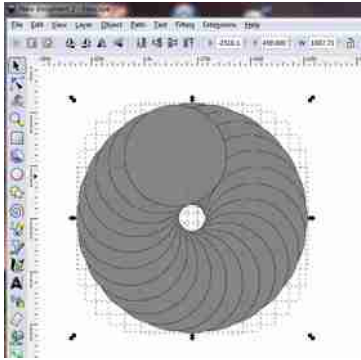
Here's an example. With the parameters can experimentieren something arise again and again new effects.



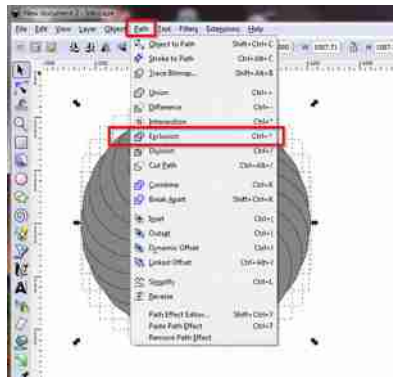
The original circuit must now be deleted.

If the object is not marked, it can also improve the transfer found the following extent.

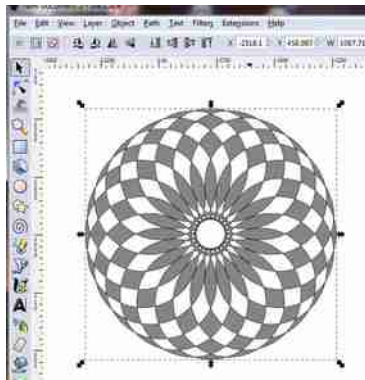
Edit -> Clone -> Select Orginal and then Delet them.



Mark all objects. The easiest way draws a rectangle with the mouse over all the circles.

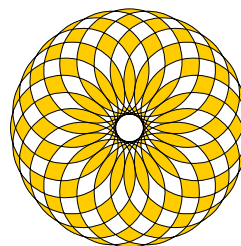
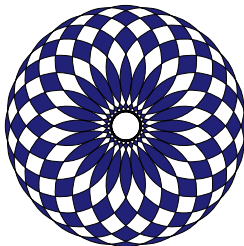


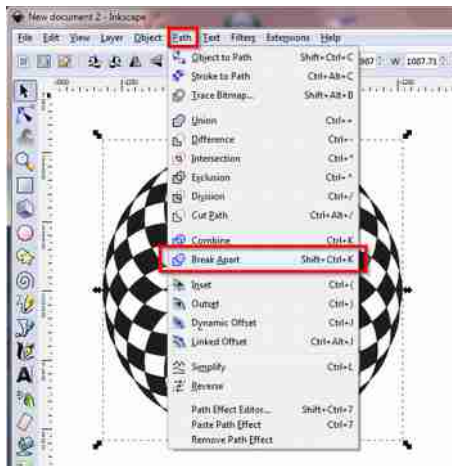
Now the "exclusion" tool can be used.



As a result now should be created a rosette with different sectors.

Now, the color can be changed. See below.

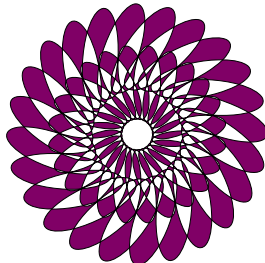
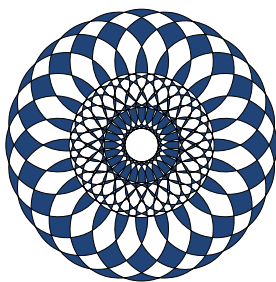
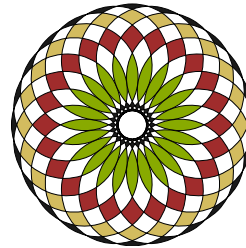




If the individual elements must get different colors yet the following steps are taken.
